








Tie Bar at Ridge













- 1. Fix Tie Bar Ridge Block/Gallery Block to Ridge using screws provided.
- 2. Screw Tie Bar Rod into Block.
- 3. Slide Tube over Rod.
- 4. Slide Boss over Rod.
- 5. Hold Boss in place with Washer and Nut.

NOTE: For a Tie Bar under the Gallery, drill Ø10mm hole though the Gallery Undercap. Fit Undercap before fitting Tube.




Tie Bar at Eaves





- 1. See **BOOK 3** Heritage Cladding for Eaves Beam preparation prior to fitting Tie Bar.
- 2. Push Tie Bar Rod through Cover Trim.
- 3. Screw Tie Bar into Eaves Beam until home.
- 4. Slide Tube over Rod
- 5. Push Rod through Boss
- 6. Secure with Washer and Nut. Nut should only be finger tight plus ¼ turn. Load will be applied to the Tie Bar as the Prop is removed.
- 7. Screw Boss Cover to Boss.




- For Glazing Bar mounted Tie Bars, screw Rod into Lug. Do not screw home.
- 2. Slide Tube over Rod.
- 3. Push Rod through Boss.
- 4. Screw Rod home against Lug.
- 5. Fit Washer and Nut as above.

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5 Way Tie Bar



- 1. Slide Boss over Rod.
- 2. Vertical Tie Bar Rod should project 30mm through the Boss.
- 3. Hold Boss in place with Washer and Nut.
- After fitting horizontal rods, screw Boss Cover to vertical Tie Bar Rod.



Wall Fixing



- 1. Accurately mark fixing position on Wall.
- 2. Drill Ø20 Hole in Wall at least 70mm deep.
- 3. Insert Plug in Wall and push home so face is flush with wall.
- I. Thread Nut and Washer onto Tie Bar Rod and screw Rod into Plug until home.
- 5. Run Washer and Nut up to face of Plug.
- 6. Using a spanner continue to tighten Nut up against the face of plug. This causes a brass insert in the plug to move forward spreading the plug and gripping the sides of the hole.
- 7. Slide Nut Cover and Tie Bar Tube over Tie Bar Rod to cover wall fixing.

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
